Garden compost

You can recycle lots of things at home to reduce pollution. Many gardeners recycle garden waste such as grass cuttings and leaves to make compost. A compost, when well-rotted, can be spread over the garden to help plants grow. You can make compost by putting garden waste on a heap, adding water and leaving it to rot down.



How to make compost

Get a compost bin.

Get a mixture of dry and wet garden waste.

Fill the bin with the garden waste.

Add water.

Leave the garden waste to rot.

Put well-rotted compost round your plants.

Put the lid on the bin.
